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### **Program Overview/Objectives**

Medical providers and nurses receive minimal formal education in the collection of evidence in sexual assault cases and the recognition of other forms of interpersonal violence. This lack of knowledge can lead to signs of abuse going unrecognized, loss or destruction of evidence and/or further unintended trauma by systemic procedures.

- 2. Discuss the components of obtaining a health history.
- 3. Identify the essential components of a psychological assessment.
- 4. Identify the essential components of a physical assessment.

- 7. Discuss the dynamics of sexual assault.
- 8. Describe psychological reactions to sexual assault.
- 9. Recognize reasons for non-reporting of sexual assault/domestic violence.

- 11. Discuss nursing management of the sexual assault patient.
